

10 deadliest foreign nightclub fires since 1970

- Disco/dance hall, Luoyang, China, December 25, 2000, 309 killed. Fire began elsewhere in shopping plaza and spread to disco.
- Ozone Disco Club, Quezon City, Philippines, March 18, 1996, 160 killed.
- Club Cinq, St. Laurent du Pont, France, November 20, 1971, 143 killed.
- Alcalá 20 disco, Madrid, Spain, December 17, 1983, 81 killed.
- Weierkang Club, Taichung, Taiwan, February 15, 1995, 64 killed. Property was a 3-story nightclub, restaurant and karaoke bar.
- Disco/dance hall, Gothenburg, Sweden, October 28, 1998, 63 killed.
- Saigon International Trade Center, Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam, October 30, 2002, 61 killed. All or nearly all deaths at wedding reception in restaurant located in same building as disco where fire began.
- Karaoke club, Urumqi, Xinjiang province, China, April 25, 1995, 51 killed.
- La Goajira nightclub, Caracas, Venezuela, December 1, 2002, 47 killed.
- Stardust Cabaret, Dublin, Ireland, February 14, 1981, 44 killed.
